- Ability to work with minimal supervision, strong organizational and time management skills with the ability to multi-task and manage competing priorities and undertake self-directed tasks.
- Proficient in Microsoft Office applications, web applications, and other related software; Point Click Care and RAI MDS software experience would be considered an asset.
- Must hold a valid Class "G" Ontario driver's license.
- Willingness to provide proof of a negative result from a 2-Step TB Skin test.
- Current satisfactory Vulnerable Sector Screening Check.
